At 4:37pm, we're proud to host the Racing Welfare Stable Staff Charity Race, supported by Racing Welfare. This special event features dedicated riders who have been raising funds for a fantastic cause. The race forms part of Racing Staff Week, an industry-wide initiative celebrating the passion, skill and commitment of racing staff across the sport. Their tireless efforts are the backbone of racing, and this initiative provides a wonderful opportunity to recognise and thank them for their invaluable contribution, including our own fantastic team here at Newbury Racecourse.



In the same spirit, we are delighted to have 11 of our Newbury Racecourse team taking part in the Racing Welfare 10 Peaks Brecon Beacons Challenge on 5th July. The team will tackle a demanding 22-mile trek across the Welsh mountains to raise funds for Racing Welfare. Further information, along with a link to support the team via their JustGiving page, can be found later in the racecard.

It is inspiring to see so many people across the industry coming together to support such a worthy cause, and we wish everyone taking part the very best of luck.

The feature race this evening is the Darley-sponsored EBF Fillies' Novice Stakes (Class 2) over 7 furlongs. Of the five runners, the Karl Burke-trained Anad looks an interesting prospect - a €150,000 daughter of State Of Rest, she was purchased at the Goffs Orby Sale last October and won nicely on debut at Wolverhampton. Another to note is the in-form partnership of Ed Walker and Kieran Shoemark, who send out Approved to make her racecourse debut. Owned and bred by SBA Racing Limited, she is a Kingman filly out of a 1m4f Listed winner.

As well as a fantastic evening of racing, we'll be showing today's FIFA World Cup action with the Portugal v Uzbekistan match broadcast from 6pm, followed by the highly anticipated England v Ghana game at 9pm. Both matches will be shown live in Filly's while the England v Ghana match will also be on the big screen following the last race.

Our popular Summer Evening Series returns next week, with three exciting raceday parties, and is once again presented by Hits Radio. Taking place across three Thursday evenings in July, each party has its own unique theme: The 70s Disco on Thursday 2nd July, The Wild Wild West on Thursday 9th July, and The Ibiza Beach Club on Thursday 23rd July. For the best value, look out for the Three-Party Pass, offering access to all three events from just £59 for a limited time.

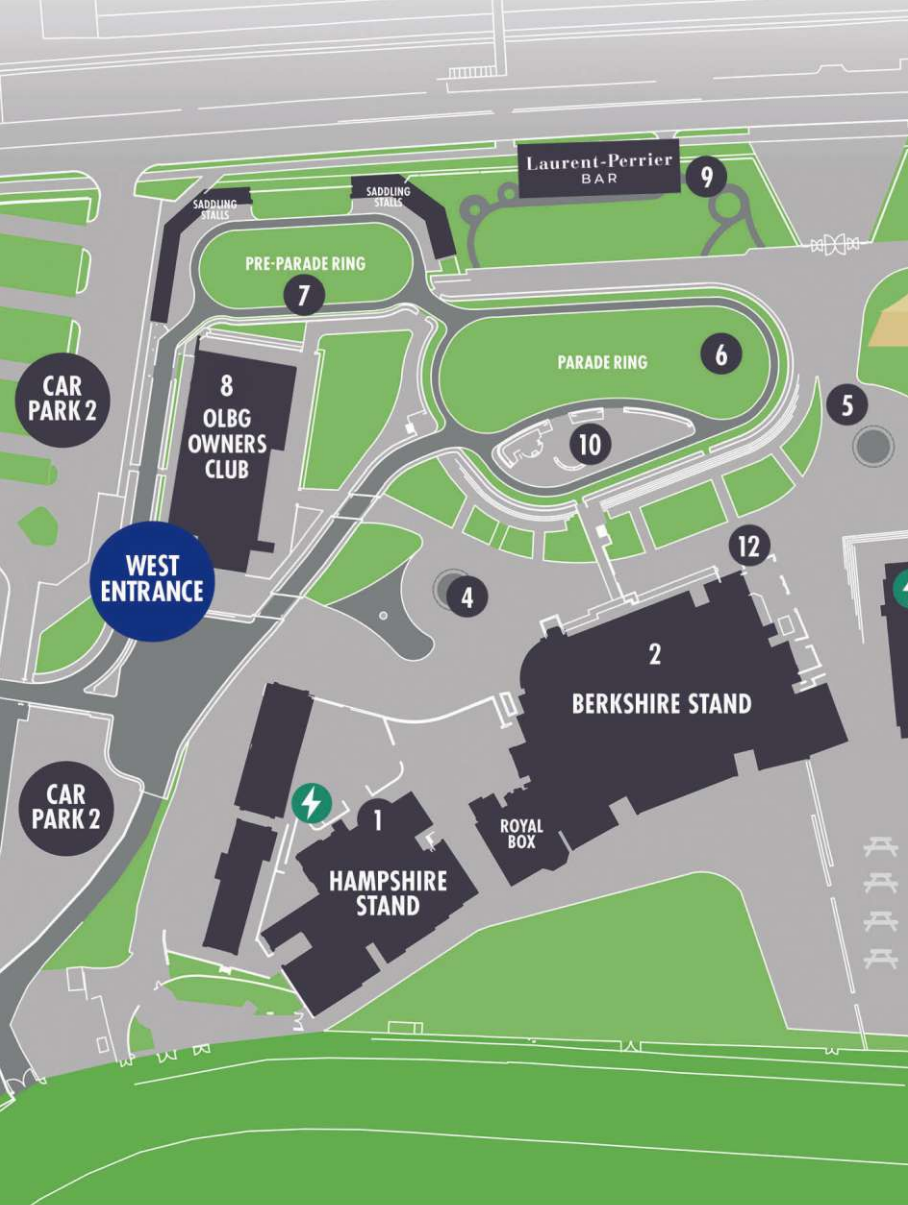

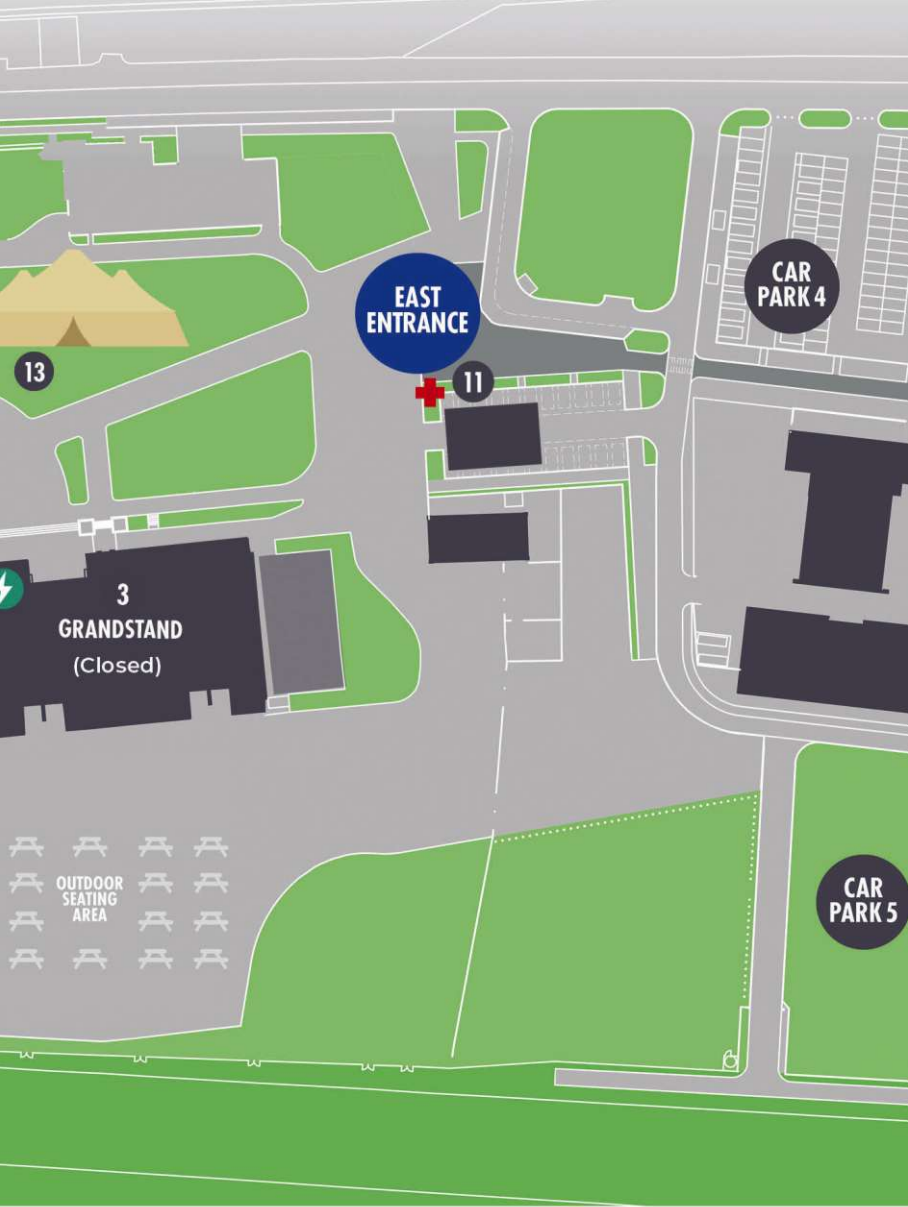

# How To Bet

There are plenty of ways to bet at Newbury – you can either bet with the bookmakers in the ‘ring’ in front of the Grandstand and the Crafty Filly, at one of the many Totepool kiosks or in one of our Betting Shops, located on the ground floor of the Dubai Duty Free Grandstand and the Berkshire Stand. Here’s a step-by-step guide of what to do:

1. Select your horse and note its name and racecard number.
2. Choose your bet – ‘To win’ or ‘each-way’ are the two most common types:
  - ‘To win’ is for your horse to come first.
  - ‘Each-way’ is when you place two bets in one: one for your horse to come first, the other for it to be placed. Therefore £2 each-way = £4 total bet.
  - What qualifies as a ‘place’ depends on the number of runners: between two and four runners - first place only; between five and seven runners - first and second place; eight runners and over - first three places; 16 runners and over (handicaps only) - first four places.
  - The place part of the bet will be paid out at a fraction of the odds, usually a quarter or a fifth - this varies depending on the bookmaker, so check if you are unsure!
3. Decide the amount, also known as the stake that you are comfortable to bet.
4. Choose your outlet and place your bet e.g. “£2 win on number three” or “£2 each-way on number six”.
5. If your horse has won, wait to hear “weighed in” over the public address system and then go and collect any winnings!
6. Got so swept up you forgot to collect your cash? There are details of how to collect winning slips after the raceday on our terms and conditions page near the back of the racecard.
